- Responsible for the day to day functions of an NAEYC accredited early childhood learning center with 110 children, supervising 28-30 faculty and support staff.
- Provides mentorship to a variety of professionals in the community, strengthening the next generation of leaders.
- Engages and partners with families to meet their goals together.
- Cultivates community relationships and partnerships for funding, including Great Start Readiness school program, Early Learning Neighborhood Collaboration, CCAMPIS, Perkins ECE funding, and Early Head Start in addition to private funding.
- Supervises and coordinates ECLL Community Liaison, including Play and Learn groups.
 - Play and Learn groups offer 90 minute caregiver and child play groups based on the Kaleidoscope model. They are offered daily in Grand Rapids Public Schools and Community spaces.
- Key contributor to the design and vision of the Phyllis Fratzke Early Childhood Learning Laboratory (ECLL)
 - Coordinator and visionary of ECLL (24,000 sq. foot, LEED certified building) that serves as a hub for early childhood education - opened January 2017. The building has won multiple design and architecture awards.
 - Worked closely with the GRCC Foundation to raise funds for the building.
 - Development of outdoor classroom for infant/toddler and preschool spaces.
